## $7^{\text {th }} / 8^{\text {th }}$ Grade Outdoor Education Trip to Catalina Island

On October 3 rd, twenty students from the 7th \& 8th grades, hopped in two vans and traveled down to Long Beach to board a ferry bound for Catalina Island. After a two hour boat ride complete with dolphin sightings, rain, and sea sickness, they arrived at Emerald Bay, a beautiful cove on the Northern tip of Catalina. The next four days found them exploring new activities and learning about conservation and biology.

But this was no ordinary learning experience -- instead of reading about fish, they put on a wetsuit and grabbed a snorkel and mask and swam with the fish. Instead of listening to a lecture about birds they lugged kayaks down to the water and paddled out to the middle of the ocean to observe the birds resting in their natural habitats. Instead of seeing a video of the physical characteristics of an invertebrate, they had a squid thrown at them and picked up their scissors and started dissecting. And instead of just hearing about how Jesus loves them, they faced their fears, with Him by their side.

Now they are back to "reality", with their school uniforms on and their textbooks in their hands, but the amazing opportunities they had -- with both learning about the world around them and learning about themselves -- continue to shine through in conversations and laughter. This was truly a trip to remember.
